Even though **Hancock Central High School** has outperformed other schools with a similar student demographic, the **AER** report may reflect some state standardized performances scored below the state average.

In addition, our Special Education Department operates with transparency during communication and collaboration with mainstream education to ensure compliance to the State of Michigan and the Federal mandate of serving a free and appropriate public education.

Hancock Central High School enrolls 232 students in grades 9 - 12. Our academic standards adhere to learning expectations for Michigan students and guide our curriculum development in core and co-curricular instruction. Course offerings include the pursuit of profiles for career and technical education developmental plans continued in grades 9 - 12.

We have a successful athletic department featuring the following programs: Ice Hockey, Football, Cross Country, Skiing, Volleyball, Basketball, Baseball, Softball, Track and Golf with the philosophy that a comprehensive educational experience includes such significant curricula.

PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL: Hancock Public Schools has one comprehensive school structure for grades 6-12 assigning students based upon age, grade level or accumulated credits.

THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN: Hancock Central High School is in its **second year** of the building 3-5 year plan. The 2018-2019 school year will see the evaluation of the school improvement plan.
